EGYPT IN A CHANGING REGIONAL AND GLOBAL ORDER

Panel Discussion Participants

Aida Abd El Rehim is an Assistant Professor at Galala University. Prior to joining Galala University, she worked for 17 years at the British University in Egypt. She holds a PhD from the University of Dundee, Scotland, UK. Her research interests include international relations, foreign policy, and international security.

Erzsébet N. Rózsa is an expert in Middle Eastern politics and security, with a focus on Egypt, Iran, the Persian/Arab Gulf, nuclear disarmament, Euro-Mediterranean cooperation, and European Muslim minorities. She holds MA degrees in English Studies, Arabic Studies, and Iranian Studies from Eötvös Loránd University, and a PhD from the Multidisciplinary Doctoral School of the University of Economics in Budapest. Between 1990 and 2016, she was a Senior Research Fellow, Executive, and later Academic Deputy Director at the Hungarian Institute of International Affairs and its successor institutions. Since 2018, she has been a full professor at the University of Public Service, and since 2021, a Doctor of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences (MTA).

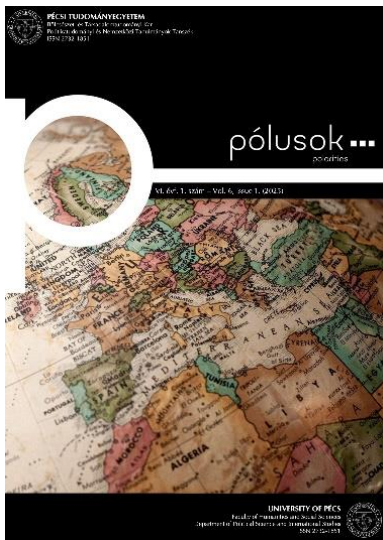

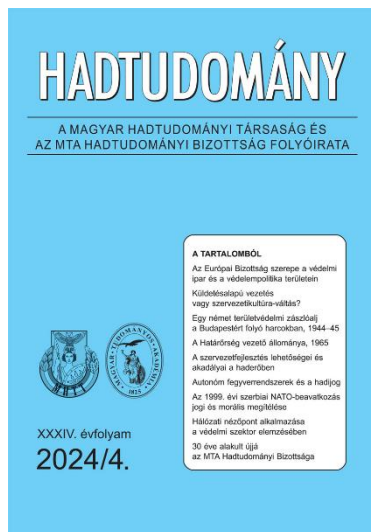

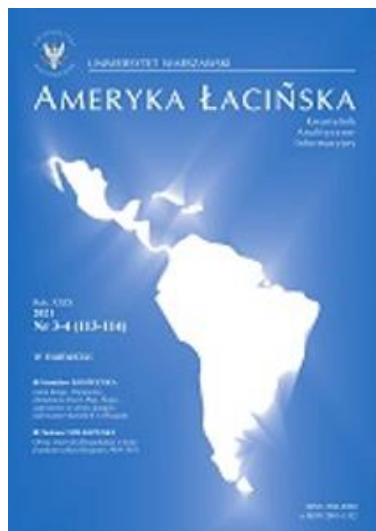
